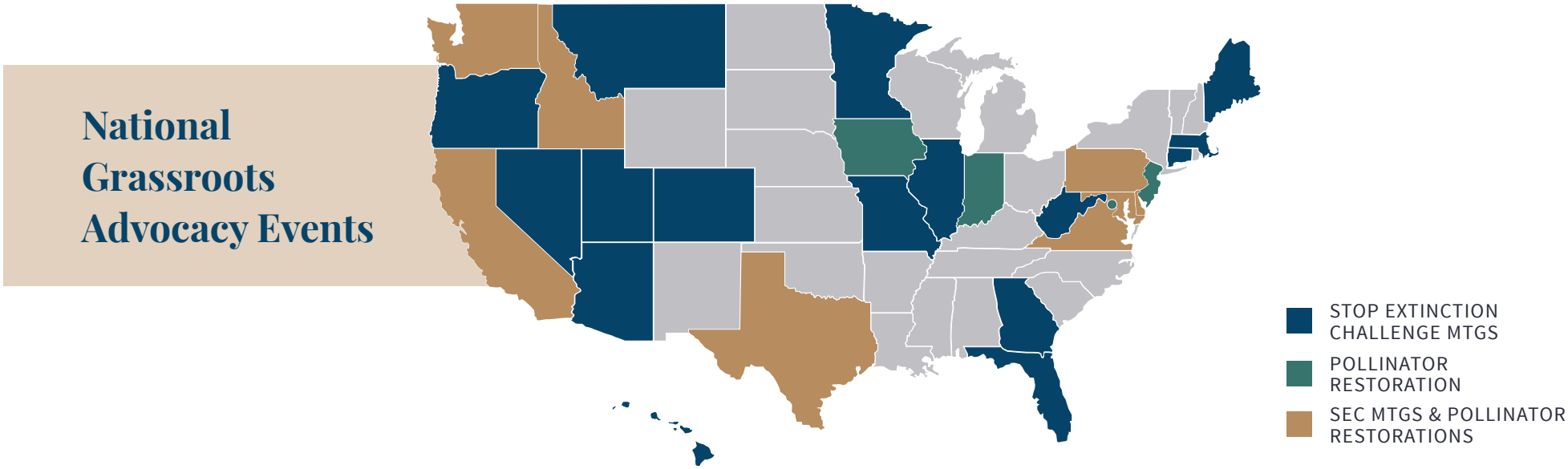




ENDANGERED SPECIES COALITION: Annual Report 2020



Countering Endangered Species Act Rollbacks

60,000 calls, emails, & petition signatures to support PAW and FIN Act

Mobilized **18 member groups** and **129 activists** to virtually attend **44 Senate meetings** in **23 states**

24 LTEs and **6 OP-EDs** published

Assisted in generating **100,000+** petition signatures urging Congress to oppose new FWS regulations weakening the ESA

Endangered Species Day

Received **1,400+** entries into Youth Art Contest

30,668 media mentions with a reach of **290+ million people**

2,694 RSVPs for our screening of the film Racing Extinction

91 activists participated in our nationwide citizen science BioBlitz

A 2030 Vision for Wildlife

Wildlife Corridors Conservation Act passed as a part of H.R. 2



Helped launch Lobos for Lobos in New Mexico to protect the Mexican gray wolf

Introduced a resolution in the Pennsylvania state House tourism committee to protect wildlife corridors

Supported **25+** pollinator habitat restoration sites = a combined total of **150+** plantings since ESC began the program



Countering the Pandemic

Congressional education, as a coalition led, to the introduction of “Preventing Future Pandemics Act of 2020” in the House and Senate

Our 2020 Top 10 Report highlighted the unsustainable wildlife trade and its connection to the current and future potential pandemics

Educational webinar & calls for donors, decision-makers & member groups featuring experts who made the link between the wildlife trade & future pandemics.

Inclusive Grassroots Democracy

Launched our Activist Training Lab with **16** participants from various backgrounds & geographic locations enrolled in a year-long grassroots activist training program

Cultivated deeper relationships in communities of color including attending events such as the 39th Annual Colorado Indian Market & Southwest Art Festival and participated in the Green Latino’s Environmental Justice Working Group call

Mobilized member groups and Allied Voices across key early primary states including Iowa, New Hampshire, South Carolina, and Nevada to get Democratic presidential candidates on the record about their stance on the ESA.

Launched a Get Out the Vote program for the 2020 elections, including a GOTV website. Nearly **1,100** users registered to vote or checked their registration/voting sites with us.
